

# DDA BESPOKE Compliance Without Upheaval



The DDA Bespoke is a vandal resistant system designed for low rise apartments, Housing Association sites, sheltered housing, housing estates, Local Authority flats, hospitals, nursing homes and disabled facilities.



The Braille buttons are halo illuminated and tactile and there is provision for up to 9 individual destination call points. A visitor presses the required button. There is visual and audible call progress indication from the 'SPEAK NOW' and 'DOOR OPEN' LED's and the Electronic Voice Assist™.

The call is answered at the destination on a standard telephone or mobile phone and conversation may take place. Once identity has been confirmed a key is pressed on the telephone the call was answered on and the visitor is given access.

There is visual and audible confirmation that the entrance has opened. Video can be provided from an integrated camera, the pictures from this camera can be transmitted to a monitor, a TV distribution amplifier (for viewing on a standard television) or added to an existing CCTV system.

The system requires either a dedicated BT type analogue phone line or a mobile phone SIM card. The installation time and upheaval caused is minimal as the wiring is already present (telephone wiring). The annual running costs are extremely low as engineer call outs are not needed to replace handsets or make repairs to cabling.
