DDA SENIOR Backlit Braille Buttons, Multi User



The DDA Senior is a vandal resistant multi user system designed for apartment blocks, Housing Associations, housing estates and Local Authority flats. The system has a large backlit LCD display with halo illuminated, backlit,

tactile, Braille stainless steel buttons enabling the calling of up to 1000 call point destinations. The display provides user instructions and gives call progress indication.

The buttons are used for scrolling to the required destination by using the up and down keys or entering the apartment number. The buttons are also used for resident access by entering the required 4 - 8 digit number.

Addresses shown on the display can be altered as required. A visitor follows the instructions on the display and scrolls to the required destination or enters the required flat number and presses call. There is visual and audible call progress indication from the backlit display and the Electronic Voice Assist™.

The call is answered at the destination on a standard telephone or mobile phone and conversation may take place. Once identity has been confirmed a key is pressed on the telephone the call was answered on and the visitor is given access. There is visual and audible confirmation that the entrance has opened.

Video can be provided from an integrated camera, the pictures from this camera can be transmitted to a monitor, a TV distribution amplifier (for viewing on a standard television) or added to an existing CCTV system.
